

## 2017 Summer Reading List- Entering 10th

The purpose of the Eagle's View Academy summer reading program is to encourage students to read and appreciate classic and contemporary literary works. Please note that the requirements for titles and number of books vary from grade to grade and class to class. All the books are available in limited quantities from the Jacksonville Public Library and local bookstores. Online retailers offer the cheapest availability, but the order should be placed soon to allow time for students to read.

Evaluation of book that the entire class is reading will done on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>. Parents, please encourage your students to read each day rather than waiting till the end of the summer. Evaluation will be on the books – not the films! Please note that any student who registers after July 28<sup>th</sup> will have a different date of evaluation as well as later due date for the book report.

**All students going into 10<sup>th</sup> grade must read *The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde* by Robert Louis Stevenson.**

**In addition to reading *The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde*, it is recommended that all students enrolled in English II Honors read *How to Read a Book* by Mortimer Alder.**
