

2022 Summer Reading List- Entering 10th

The purpose of the Eagle's View Academy summer reading program is to encourage students to read and appreciate classic and contemporary literary works. Please note that the requirements for titles and number of books vary from grade to grade and class to class. All the books are available in limited quantities from the Jacksonville Public Library and local bookstores. Online retailers offer the cheapest availability, but the order should be placed soon to allow time for students to read.

Students should read a book listed below and complete a chapter summary for each chapter in the book. The chapter summaries will be turned in to their Language or Literature teacher by Monday, August 15th. Parents, please encourage your students to read each day rather than waiting till the end of the summer. Please note that any student who registers after July 22nd will have a different date by which to turn in their chapter summaries.

All students going into 10th grade must read one of the following books:

***Gifted Hands* by Ben Carson**

***The Screwtape Letters* by C. S. Lewis**

***Robinson Crusoe* by Daniel Defoe**

***Eats, Shoots & Leaves: The Zero Tolerance Approach to Punctuation*
by Lynne Truss**

All students going into Honors English II are required to read an additional one of the four books (2 total) and complete a chapter summary for each of chapter of the book.
